his Wife, having proposed Marriage with each
other before a Monthly Meeting of the religious
Society of Friends held at Baltimore, aforesaid,
and having Consent of Surviving Parents
their said Marriage was allowed of
by the said meeting.

Now these are to certify whom it may
Concern, That for the full accomplishment
of their said proposal this Twenty fourth day
of the Fifth month, in the year of our Lord
One thousand eight hundred and eighty seven
they, the said Thomas Kimber Worthington &
