3rd mo. 14th 1805 - The Committee appointed to dispose of
a part of our meeting land, report that they had dispos-
ed of 4 lots fronting on Great York Street of 28 feet
each & deep for the sum of \$2680 - payable at 3
\$ to month - The same friends are continued to furnish
the Treasurer of the building committee with the money
as it may become payable, or such party thereof as may
be necessary & to attend to having the Deed of Convey-
ance made to the purchaser, after the money is paid & to
report to this meeting when ready.
