As a circumstance we presume, never contemplated by the Yearly Meeting — Or that a connection should take place between the meetings — "To have the joint care of the Burying Ground — Ordering of Interments — Oversight thereof — Enclosures and repairs &c," as proposed by their committee. — " — " — " — "

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A connection of this kind we are of opinion, could never be approbated by the Eastern District, when the effect of their Control, would evidently have a tendency to produce continuous uneasiness and dissatisfaction. — " — " — "

We wish not to take up the attention of the Yearly Meeting or its committee unnecessarily — but we cannot well forbear expressing the painful sensations that have been produced to our Meeting whenever the subject was introduced by them. — A respectful attention to the communications of a neighbouring monthly meeting was demanded on the one hand — when on the other, we have
