minutes relative to the late Act of Assembly, Perpetuating the Trusteeship of the Property belonging to our monthly meeting, and from a consideration of the apprehensions suggested, we believe it may be necessary to state that by a reference to our minutes, it appears, that the property at the east end of the City belonging to this meeting, and held by Trustees under the authority of an Act of the Legislature passed in 1793. was by them in the year 1800.
