in the course of their investigation, found it necessary, to consult counsel,
from which it appeared, that no legal conveyance, could be made by the
original Trustees, without a special act of the Legislature passed for that
particular purpose. The Property appearing to be thus circumstanced
and but two of the original Trustees living it became not only necessary,
but the Duty of the Meeting, agreeably to Discipline and the established
order of Society to take the necessary care, that the Trusteeship was
properly and legally renewed, in doing this it has been careful that
nothing should be done, to infringe on the Rights or Privileges granted
to your meeting, by the late decisions of the Yearly meetings but effect-
ually to secure to each and every Person and Persons their several and
respective rights, agreeably to the original intention, a provision however
has been made, for the future appointment of Trustees, by the Monthly
Meeting, with a view to avoid troubling the Legislature in future,
when such appointments should become necessary
