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 that meeting for worship, be held there not long after, for
 the privilege of a preparative & monthly meeting, by the
 names, Lombard Street meetings, preparative & monthly,
 all of which was granted, & afterwards confirmed by the
 the court. maff was applied for, before the subject was, of the same meeting,
 Quaker meeting for communion, where the latter became
 changed to the "Eastern & Western District"
 Since the separation, friends remaining within the name
 of the ~~meeting house~~, they have been subject to a very heavy
 incumbrance on the property, as follows -

 that meeting have clear & equal rights, titles & privileges
 in the balance of the property remaining in common with
 the members of the Baltimore mo't meeting for the eastern
 District" - which was ^{acclaimed} considered to be both unreasonable
 & oppressive. ^{that of} Accepting the privilege of an

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 termination of their members in the burying, which they
 were at liberty at all times freely to partake of ^{especially}
^{when the balance of the property was so reduced off}
 the forced sale, to complete the furnishing of the new meeting
 house, that the balance remaining was no more than will
 conveniently answer the purposes for which it was confirmed
 by the Legislative Vitz. For a meeting house & yard -
 & concluded a proposal was intro-
 duced to change the names not only
 of these meets, but Bath. m. maff al.
 so to be distinguished by the western
 & Eastern District, which was given way

 brance or difficulty in future could possibly arise therefrom

We now think it may be right to turn our attention
 to some of the representations contained in their report
 Narrative - wherein they state, that "the monthly
 meeting of Baltimore for the eastern District having
 refused to admit any right of friends of the western District
 to the property - an appeal was carried to our Yearly meet-
 ing" - For the reasons before assigned, it was considered
 that they could have no just claim to it, more than any
 other monthly meeting - but that friends of the 1st monthly
 meeting were at liberty to enter in our grounds as heretofore
