who were directed to report to next meeting."

The following is a copy of the Memorial to the General
Assembly of Maryland.

The Memorial of the Society of Friends, or people
called Quakers, constituting the monthly meetings of Baltimore for the Eastern
and Western Districts, respectfully represents that it appears that the Law
passed at November Session 1812. for perpetuating the trust in certain pro-
perty belonging to the Society of Friends, lying in the east end of the City of
Baltimore, does not fully embrace the objects of said Society, and it being
desirable that the monthly Meetings of Baltimore for the Eastern and Western
Districts, should each have an equal number of Trustees for the purpose of
preserving and perpetuating the trust Estate, and securing the rights of

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said property, to the Society of Friends, we therefore request that a Supplement
to the said Law may pass embracing the objects set forth in this Memorial.

A Supplement to the Act, entitled an Act vesting the property there-
in mentioned in certain Trustees for the use and benefit of the Society of
Friends, or People called Quakers, constituting the Monthly Meeting of Balti-
more for the Eastern District in the City of Baltimore.

Whereas, the Society of Friends constituting the Monthly
Meetings of Baltimore for the Eastern and Western Districts of said City,
have set forth by their Memorial, to this assembly, that it is desirable, that the
Monthly Meetings aforesaid should possess equal rights and privileges, in the
appointment of Trustees and in preserving and perpetuating the Trust Estate
for the uses and purposes particularly described and set forth in the act to
which this is a Supplement.

Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, that the Monthly
Meeting of Friends for the Western District in the City of Baltimore, be and is
hereby invested with equal rights and privileges with the Monthly Meeting
for the Eastern District in said City in preserving and perpetuating the trust
estate, owned by the Society of Friends, which is particularly described in the
Act to which this is a Supplement.

And be it further enacted, that
Members of the Monthly Meeting for the Western District their heirs and assigns
