

I have carefully examined the various proceedings
of the monthly quarterly & yearly meetings of the friends
in Baltimore relative to their property in the eastern
part of the city - as also the acts of assembly & petitions
thereto on the same subject - from all which I think
it is most manifest -

1st That ~~express~~ the yearly meeting in their
first & second deliberation on that subject have
formally & precisely decided that the title to the
property in the Eastern part of the city belonged to
the monthly meeting for the Eastern District to the
exclusion of that of the 2nd monthly meeting for the
Western District not by virtue of any decision of
that body nor by compromise between the
two monthly meetings - but that the title was in
them by the deeds & terms of purchase - & these decisions
do not even recognize an equitable interest in the
monthly meeting for the Western District.

2 That the General Assembly have in possession
