Month 1832 C

Answer 1st Our Meetings for worship on first days have
been attended generally by our members when of ability to
do so with the exception of those who have seceded. Those in
the middle of the week & for discipline are not so well attended.
Unbecoming behaviour therein has been mostly avoided and
the hour of meeting nearly observed.

Answer 2nd Friends generally maintain love towards each
other in a degree becoming our Christian profession; tale
bearing and detraction are generally discouraged. No
differences have arisen requiring the attention of this meeting.

Answer 3rd With the exception in the first query No offenders
have come to the knowledge of this meeting.
