behaviour therein generally avoided, and the hour of Meeting
nearly observed.

Second As far as appears. Friends are careful to maintain Love
towards each other becoming our Christian profession, Talebear-
ing and detraction are discouraged, and when differences arise,
endeavours are used to end them.

Ninth A concern is manifested to endeavour as far as
practicable to deal with offenders in the manner recommended.
