be generally maintained, frequently Taverns & Gaming places of
ill repute are mostly avoided. Moderation & Temperance
are generally observed;

Fifth The Ministers of the Sacraments and the Circumstances of those
likely to require Vice are Inspectors and relief afforded
and attention is paid to the further requisitions of the
same when Occasions requires;

Sixth Our Testimony against a heretical Ministry, Oaths
Military Services & Unchristian Trade. These Goods and
Lotteries appear to be generally maintained;

Seventh We believe Friends are mostly careful to Live within
the Bounds of their Circumstances & to Avoid Involving themselves
in Debts beyond their Abilities to manage. To be Just in
their dealings and Punctual in complying with their Engagements
and when any good reason shall appear for fearfully
respects Care is extended;

Eighth As far as appears Friends are careful to Live as
Testimony against Slavery. Those of the African race
in private families are provided for. & we believe Care is taken
to instruct them in Useful Learning
