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At Baltimore Preparative Meeting for the Eastern & Western Districts (in unity with the Ancient Yearly Meetings of Friends) held the 30<sup>th</sup> of 5<sup>mo</sup> 1833.

The first, second and ninth Queries were read in this Meeting and the following answers agreed on. Joseph King Junr & John P. Balderson were appointed to attend the ensuing Monthly Meeting therewith as representatives on behalf of this and directed to report to next Meeting.

First Answer. All our Meetings for Worship and discipline have been held, and attended by most of our Members on first day mornings, who have not joined in the separation, afternoon and week days, Continue to be neglected by some, Unbecoming behaviour in Meetings avoided, and <sup>the</sup> hour of Meeting mostly observed;

Second. Friends appear to maintain love towards each other becoming our Christian profession, Talebearing and detraction are discouraged and we know of no differences amongst us;

Ninth. Endeavours are used to deal with offenders in the manner recommended;
