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At Baltimore Preparative Meeting for the Eastern and Western Districts in Unity with the Ancient yearly Meetings of Friends held the 29th of the 5th Month 1834.

The first - second, and Ninth Queries were read in this Meeting and the following answers adopted, to be forwarded in our Report to the Ensueing Monthly Meeting - to attend which as our Representatives - Nicholas Popplein & John Dukehart are appointed.

First Answer. All our Meetings for Worship and discipline have been held: those on first day Mornings are generally duly attended: the Afternoon Meetings and those in the middle of the week, frequently neglected by many. Unbecoming behaviour therein generally avoided and the hour of Meeting nearly observed.

Second Answer. We believe that Friends maintain love ^{bearing} towards each other becoming our Christian Profession. Tale and detraction are discouraged and when differences arise endeavours are used to end them.

Ninth Answer. A concern is maintained to endeavour to deal with offenders in the manner queried.

William G Thomas. Richard S. Howland. Edward S. Shives Charles Elias Wethered and John Wethered: Have individually associated themselves with those who have separated from communion with the Ancient Society of Friends: they have neglected the attendance of our Religious Meetings, & are in connection with Meetings not acknowledged by our Yearly Meeting: thus identifying themselves with the seceders and evidencing unity with their principles.

Isaac McPherson has joined in membership with another religious Society.
