— Answer 7th Friends are so far as appears careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances and to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage just in their dealings and mostly punctual in complying with their engagements

— Answer 8th Friends are careful to bear a testimony against slavery, those of the african race under our direction are provided for and some attention has been paid to instructing them in useful learning

— Answer 9th Except those who have joined in the separation Cane has been taken to deal with offenders seasonably and impartially, and to evince to those whom will not be reclaimed the spirit of meekness and love before they are disowned

— Answer 10th — None —

— Answer 11th — None —

— Answer 12th — Careful in this respect.
