To Gunpowder Monthly Meeting,

Dear Friends,

In my Communication to your committee dated 8th Mo 28th 1836, I stated that I was clear of ^apart of the charge, exhibited against me by Baltimore Monthly Meeting, but on more mature reflection, I now find that I was mistaken, As I was in the practice of attending Sandy Spring Meeting, after the Separation, and until near the time of my removal from that Neighborhood, I therefore now Acknowledge the Correctness of the Charge against me,
