A communication was received from Baltimore Monthly Meeting more than a year ago requesting Gwynedd Monthly Meeting to treat with Isaac Garrison on their behalf which was attended to and the result communicated shortly after. And I understood from Dr Richard H Thomas (whom I saw at Phil^a Yearly Meeting last spring) that you had received our communication and would send us something further on the subject. Not having ever received anything from you since the first letter - I have been induced to think it probable that your communication (if I understood Dr Thomas correctly that one was sent) must have miscarried and that you are probably not aware of the fact. If however you have resulted ^{case} the in some way not requiring the further intervention of our services we are well content and hope this communication will be excused and ascribed to the proper motive viz a desire to promote the proper execution of ^{the} discipline of our religious society.
