Second Ans^r. - We believe Friends generally maintain love towards each other becoming our Christian profession Talebearing and detraction are discouraged, and when differences arise endeavors are used to end them -

Ninth Ans^r. - Endeavors are used to deal with offenders seasonably and impartially, and ^{to} evince to those who will not be so, claimed the spirit of meekness and love.
