

7th Ans^r. As far as appears Friends live within the bounds of their Circumstances & avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage, and are just in their dealings and generally punctual in complying with their engagements.

8th Ans^r. Friends are careful to bear a testimony against slavery, except in one instance, which is under care. — Those of the African race under their direction we believe are suitably provided for & some care taken to instruct them in useful learning.

9th Ans^r. — Endeavours are used to deal with offenders in the manner recommended.

10th Ans^r. — None.

11th Ans^r. — None.

12th Ans^r. — Friends generally are careful as far as practicable, to place their Childrens for tuition, under the Charge of teachers who are members of our religious Society.
