are often small. No unbecoming behaviour or remarks,
and the hour of meeting mostly observed.

Second Ans^r. Friends generally maintain love towards each other
becoming our Christian profession, Talebearing & detraction
are discouraged: and when differences arise, endeavors
are used to end them.

ninth ans^r. Care is generally taken to deal with offenders sea-
sonably & impartially, & to evince to those who will
not be reclaimed, the spirit of meekness & Love.
