The 1st 2^d and 9th Queries were read in this meeting and the following Answers adopted to be forwarded in our report to the ensuing monthly meeting to attend which as our representatives Richard M. Tanny & Richard H. Thomas are appointed.

First Answer - All our Meetings for Worship and discipline have been held - and on first day mornings generally well attended, but those in the afternoon and in the mid-
-dle of the week are frequently small, unbecoming behaviour therein mostly avoided: and the hour of Meeting generally observed.

Second Answer - Friends generally maintain love towards each other becoming our Christian profession tale bearing and detraction are discouraged, and when differences arise, endeavours are used to end them. —

Ninth Answer - Endeavours are used to deal with Offenders seasonably and impartially, and to evince to those who will not be reclaimed, the Spirit of meekness and love. —
