First Ans. - All our meetings for worship & Discipline have been held, those on first day mornings are generally duly attended, but a remissness is apparent on the part of some of our members in the attendance of other meetings - Unbecoming behaviour therein mostly avoided & the hour of meetings nearly observed -

Second Ans. We believe that friends generally maintain love towards each other becoming our Christian profession - Tale bearing & detraction are discouraged & when differences arise, endeavours are used to end them.

ninth Ans. Endeavours are used to deal with offenders in the manner queried -
