

At a Meeting for Sufferings held in Paris the 29th of the
10th Month 1836.

The Committee appointed to take charge of 50 Copies
of the Bible received from Friends of Great Britain made
the following Report, which was approved; the Committee were
continued to comply with the proposition therein contained
and the Clerk is directed to furnish the respective Monthly
Meetings with a copy of the Report and of this Minute.

To the Meeting for Sufferings,

The Committee to have charge of the distribution
of the fifty copies of the Bible received from Friends of
Great Britain, Report, that some further attention than
been given to the subject and that since our appointment
twenty eight Copies have been distributed agreeably to the
direction of the Meeting. On conferring together we
we have agreed to propose that the remaining twenty two
Copies be divided amongst the Monthly Meetings in the
following proportions to be distributed by them to such
of their Members whose circumstances may render a Copy
acceptable and desirable, viz:

Battersea Monthly Meeting 4, Gunpowder 2, Hopewell 3,
Deer Creek 2, Nottingham & Britain 3, Bellefonte 2,
and Dunning's Creek 6.

This proposition is submitted to the Meeting under
the belief that the Copies remaining on hand could in that
way be more judiciously distributed than by this Committee
all of whom reside within the limits of one of the
Monthly Meetings.
