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Whereas William W. Moore has had a right of membership
in the religious Society of Friends, but has deviated from the good
order thereof & manifested that he is not in unity with us by joining
with others in holding meetings insubordinate to our long
established Yearly Meeting & subversive of its Discipline, for which
labour has been unavailingly extended towards him, but he not
manifesting any disposition to condemn the same & it appearing
that further labour would have no good effect; We do therefore
hereby disown him the said William W. Moore from all right
of Membership in the religious Society of Friends, until he shall
see his error & condemn the same to the satisfaction of Friends;
which that he may be enabled to do is our sincere desire.
