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Our Friend Gerard F Hopkins, a Minister in unity
with us, in a weighty manner opened in this meeting
a prospect which has for some time rested upon his
mind. To pay a religious visit to all the Meetings
of Friends constituting Baltimore Yearly Meeting;
and also to appoint Meetings as they may open
in some places and neighbourhoods, where friends
have no Meetings settled; which claiming our serious
consideration was fully united with by both Men
and Womens Meetings, and he left to his liberty and
encouraged to pursue his prospects, as truth may
point out. The Clerk was directed to unite with
the Clerk of Womens Meeting in furnishing him
with a copy of this minute, signed on behalf
of this Meeting, Extracted from the Minutes of
the Baltimore Monthly Meeting for the Eastern
and Western Districts (in unity with the Ancient
Yearly Meetings of Friends) held the 9th day
of the 12th Month. 1830,
