4th Answer. Our testimony against distilled spirituous liquors appears to be maintained agreeably to our Discipline, frequenting of Taverns, or attending places of diversion avoided, moderation and temperance are generally observed

5th Answer. The necessities of the Poor and the circumstances of those likely to require aid are inspected and relief afforded - and some attention is paid to the other requisitions of this query

6th Answer. As far as appears our testimony against a hieling Ministry, Baths, Military services, clandestine trades, Prize goods and Lotteries is maintained

7th Answer. We believe Friends are generally careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances, and to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage - to be just in their dealings, and punctual in complying with their engagements - and where any deficiencies in these respects appear, care is extended

8th Answer. Our testimony against slavery is maintained - Those of the African race in Friends families are provided for, and some care is taken to instruct them in useful learning
