

The committee appointed to unite with the Yearly Meetings Committee in ²⁵ extending leave to the subordinate meetings produced the following Report - which being read and considered was approved, and the committee were continued to attend Indian Spring Preparative Meeting in the 7th month next; the clerk was directed to furnish Baltimore Monthly Meeting and Indian Spring Preparative Meeting with a copy of the Report and of this Minute. The committee were also directed to continue their attention to the other Branches of the Quarterly Meeting and as way may open visit them and Report their care to next meeting, and Thomas Scott of Sunpowder was now added to that committee.

" The committee appointed in the 12th month last to unite with the Yearly Meetings' committee in visiting as way may open the subordinate meetings and members, and extending such advice and assistance as might appear necessary. Report.

That Friends of Indian

Spring Preparative Meeting have for some time past, regularly held their Meetings for Worship in accordance with the directions of the Yearly Meetings and with the concurrence and approbation of the Yearly Meetings committee, we are free to propose: - that they be advised and encouraged to hold their Preparative Meeting in like manner select from those who have joined in the Separation; and that the members in unity with us, residing ^{with} in the District of Columbia & its Vicinity who now constitute a Meeting for Worship held by direction and under the sanction of the Yearly Meetings Committee, be attached to said Preparative Meeting, and that it be held at the usual time of holding said Meeting, alternately at Indian Spring and Washington; to be known and distinguished as heretofore by the name of Indian Spring Preparative Meeting; and that the said Preparative Meeting should for the present be united to, and Report to Baltimore Monthly Meeting for the Eastern and Western districts, instead of Indian Spring Monthly Meeting.

That the said Preparative Meeting be held at Indian Spring in the 7th month next; and the Meeting for Worship there and at Washington respectively, in the week of the monthly and Preparative Meeting be discontinued,
