

At Baltimore Preparative Meeting for the Eastern & Western Districts (in unity with the Ancient Yearly Meetings of Friends) held the 3<sup>rd</sup> of the 6 Month 1830

The 1. 2 & 9<sup>th</sup> Queries were read in this Meeting and the following answers thereto agreed on, William Proctor, & Samuel Carey, were appointed to attend the ensuing Monthly Meeting therewith as our Representatives

First, All our Meetings both for worship and Discipline, have been held, and generally attended by most of our Members who have not joined in the Separation, unbecoming behaviour therein, avoided, and the hour of Meeting mostly observed.

Second, Those of our Members who attend our Meetings, Maintain Love towards each other becoming our Christian profession, Slandering and detraction are discouraged, and with the exception noted in the First answer, we know of no differences amongst us.

Ninth, Care is taken to deal with offenders in the manner recommended, with the exception of those who remain in the Separation;
