Meeting.

1st Answer No account has at this
time been received from the Cliffs Meeting.
All our other Meetings both for Worship
and Discipline have been held, and gene-
rally attended by most of our members,
[except those who have joined in the sepa-
ration] unbecoming behavior therein
mostly avoided, and the hour of meeting
generally observed.

2nd Answer As far as appears, those of
our members who attend our Meetings,
maintain Love towards each other becoming
our Christian profession, forbearing and
distruction are discouraged and with the
exception noted in the first Answer we
know of no differences amongst us.

3rd Answer Endeavours are used to deal
with offenders in the manner recomman-
ded, with the exception of those who remain
in the separation

has had his Marriage accomplished Con-
-trary to the order of our Society.

Also, that Samuel Hopkins, has had
his Marriage, accomplished Contrary to
the order of our Society. referred to the
