

The Committee appointed in the 3rd month last to procure a lot or lots of Ground and erect a Building thereon, suitable for the accommodation of the meetings of the members of our religious Society residing within the City and County of Baltimore.

Report.

That they have secured two lots of Ground each Twenty six feet front on Saratoga Street and extending back on Courtland Street One Hundred Feet to an Alley. One of these lots has been purchased in Fee for 1400 dollars and the other taken on Ground Rent at 80 dollars per annum, with the privilege after the Year 1840 of buying off the annuity for 1333. 30. Both these lots have been conveyed in Trust to Nicholas Popplein Daniel Cobb, Hugh Balderson, Joseph King Sur^r. George Williamsow, Isaac Brooks, Elisha V. Brown and Samuel Carey for the use and benefit of the Society of Friends residing in the City and County of Baltimore, now constituting and which may hereafter constitute Baltimore Monthly Meeting for the Eastern and ~~the~~ Western District in unity with the Ancient Yearly Meetings of Friends. The Building and other Improvements including the amount paid for one of the lots have cost $7,699 \frac{64}{100}$ dollars of which sum there has been received $6,252 \frac{50}{100}$ dollars from the Committee who have had charge of the subscription and the deficiency obtained on loan for one Year as authorized by the Monthly meeting. The title Papers Policy of Insurance and Vouchers for the payments made have all been lodged in the hands of the Recorder.

The committee feel thankful in having thus been able to effect the objects of their appointment.
