agreed on to be forwarded to the Monthly Meeting
by Isaiah B Hopkins & Enoch Wilson who are
appointed our representatives, they being understood as
not having reference to those who stand in the separation

Answer 1st All our Meetings for Worship on First days have
been attended by our Members generally, those in
the Middle of the Week & for Discipline are not
so well attended, Unbecoming behaviour therein
mostly avoided & the hour of Meeting nearly observed

Answer 2nd Most Friends are careful to maintain Love towards
each other, we trust, becoming our Christian profession,
Tale bearing & detraction have by most Friends been
discouraged. And we know of no differences requiring
attention by this Meeting

Answer 3rd Most Friends endeavor by example & precept
to educate their Children & those under their care
in plainness of speech deportment & apparel, to
guard them against reading pernicious books
& from the corrupt conversation of the world,
and encourage their reading the holy scriptures

Answer 4th Our testimony against distilled spirituous liquors
appears to be maintained agreeably to our discipline
excepting in some instances a little being hunted
out in time of harvest. Friends avoid frequent-
-ing Taverns, or attending places of diversion.
And observe Moderation & temperance on
most occasions.

Answer 5th None of this description among us.
