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Fifth answer. The necessities of the poor, and the circumstances of those likely to require aid, are inspected and relief afforded, and attention is paid to the further requisitions of this query when occasion requires.

Sixth answer. Our testimony against a hireling ministry, oaths, military services, clandestine trade, prize goods and lotteries appear to be generally maintained.

Seventh answer. We believe Friends are mostly careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances, to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their abilities to manage; to be just in their dealings and punctual in complying with their engagements; and when any give reasonable ground for fear in these respects care is extended to them.

Eighth answer. As far as appears Friends are careful to bear a testimony against slavery. Those of the African race in Friends families are provided for, and we believe care is taken to instruct them in useful learning.

Ninth answer. Endeavours are used to deal with offenders in the manner recommended.

Tenth answer. None.

Eleventh answer. None.

Twelfth answer. Some Friends are careful to place their children for tuition under the charge of teachers in membership with us, but much difficulty is experienced by Friends in this particular, for the want of suitable schools taught by members of our society, and more care in reference to

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
