The Committee to visit Charles Little, on behalf of the Monthly Meeting of Baltimore, reported in writing as follows:

"We have visited Charles Little, on the complaint preferred against him by Baltimore Monthly Meeting - He received us kindly and appeared to be somewhat imprev'd with the impropriety of holding the Commission he does, as being inconsistent with the principles of the Society, but gave no encouragement that he would relinquish it."

The Report was approved by the Meeting and the Clerk was directed to forward a copy of it to Baltimore Monthly Meeting.
