for the Eastern & Western districts on account of his
having had his marriage accomplished contrary to
the order of our religious Society Report they had a
full opportunity with him, and in addition to that
charge they have understood he has recently failed;
having contracted debts beyond his ability to pay,
which being mentioned to him he did not deny.
And on being threatened with him on those accounts
he appeared friendly, but did not believe him to be
so convinced of his errors as to enable him profitably
to condemn them, with which this meeting unites
and directs him to transmit to that meeting a certified copy of this minute
