

1st Answer. All our Meetings for Worship and Discipline have been held. Those on First-day Mornings are attended by our Members generally; those in the evening and in the middle of the week not so well attended (but much better attended than formerly). Unbecoming behavior avoided, and the hour nearly observed.

2nd Answer. Friends appear to maintain love towards each other becoming our Christian profession. Tale-bearing and detraction are discouraged. No differences apparent amongst us.

3rd Answer. Friends mostly endeavor by example and precept to bring up their children and those under their care in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, and in the plainness of speech, deportment & apparel which the Gospel enjoins; they endeavor to guard them against reading pernicious books, and from the corrupt conversation of the world & they encourage them to read the Holy Scriptures.

4th Answer. We believe that our testimony to a free Gospel Ministry is generally maintained.

5th Answer. Our testimony against distilled Spirituous liquors is maintained so far as we know. Frequenting taverns & attending places of diversion we believe are avoided & moderation and temperance are generally observed.

6th Answer. No poor amongst us requiring aid.

7th Answer. Friends maintain a faithful testimony against oaths, military service, clandestine trade, prize goods, lotteries and Slavery. Those of the African race under our care are suitably provided for & they are instructed in useful learning.

8th Answer. Friends appear careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances and avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage, or engaging in hazardous or speculative trade or defrauding the Public revenue. They appear to be just in their dealings and punctual in complying with their engagements.

9th Answer. Care is taken to deal with offenders seasonably and impartially & to strive to those who will not be reclaimed the Spirit of meekness and love before judgment is placed upon them.

12th Answer. Care is taken, as far as practicable to place children for tuition under the charge of suitable teachers in membership with us.
