"to visit in the love of the Gospel Great Britain, Ireland and some of the adjacent islands, to attend the ensuing Yearly Meetings of London and Dublin & most of the meetings composing them, and to appoint some meetings with those not Friends especially amongst the poorer classes." In the prosecution of this service which had occupied nearly two years, she gratefully acknowledged the loving-kindness and faithfulness of the Lord who had enabled her to perform the work to which she believed herself called and who had granted her in its accomplishment, much peace and quiet rest at His feet.
