erecting a suitable building for a school
house, on the lot adjoining Friends Meeting
house, corner of Eutaw and Monument
streets, fronting on Eutaw street, said build-
ing to be the property of, and owned by the

"Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends"

"for the Eastern and Western Districts in"

"Unity with the Ancient Yearly Meeting of Friends"

And to be planned and erected under the
supervision of a committee to be appointed
by said Monthly Meeting

It is my desire that the building be
commenced at an early day, and be prose-
cuted to completion, and if not completed
in my life time, and the amount sub-
scribed not all paid, I hereby authorize
and instruct my Executors and assigns
to pay any balance due - so that the ag-
gregate sum paid before or after my
death shall not exceed the sum of Twenty
thousand dollars
