rected to report to our next meeting

1st Answer - All our meetings for
Worship and Discipline, have been

held; those on First day mornings are attended
by our members generally; those in the
evening and in the middle of the week are
neglected by many. Unbecoming behavior
is avoided, and the hour of meeting is
pretty generally observed

2nd Answer - We believe Friends maintain
Love towards each other becoming our Chris-
tian profession; talebearing and detraction are
discouraged, and when differences arise, en-
deavors are used to end them

9th Answer - Care is generally taken
to deal with offenders seasonably and
impartially, and to exhort to those who
will not be reclaimed, the spirit of
meekness and Love, before judgement
is placed upon them
