Our dear friend Deborah C Thomas, in returning the minute granted her in 10th month 1873 informed the meeting that through the mercy and loving-kindness of her Heavenly Father she has been enabled to attend the Yearly Meeting in Dublin in 1874, and the London Yearly Meeting succeeding it, and the meetings of Friends throughout England ^{with a few exceptions}, together with all the meetings in Scotland and Wales - She continued in that Service, including some of the Quarterly and monthly meetings, until the London Yearly Meeting in 1875, which she also attended.

She finished attending the meetings in England about the 1st of 8th month last, when she went to Ireland - After attending about 20 meetings there, circumstances in the family of her companion, rendered it necessary for them to consider seriously, whether the time had not come for them to return home, and after a time of much prayer, she was favored with a peaceful release.
