

other expenses connected with the carrying on of the School - He is to receive all surplus until it amounts to \$1400, after which it is to be equally divided between him & the Committee.

Five per Cent shall be deducted from the bills of Friends Children, for every \$100 received by him over the \$1400 for two years, and thereafter 10 per Cent for each \$100 he receives, until the reduction is 33 1/3 per Cent.

He is to conduct the School in the interest of Friends, but he is not required to take the Scholars to our meetings.

This agreement is for 5 years, but either party can terminate it, by giving 3 months notice, before the close of a Scholastic year.

Answers to the Queries

Answer 1st - Meetings for Worship & Discipline on First day Mornings are duly and punctually attended by our members generally. In the evening and on Fifth days the attendance has been small - No unbecoming behavior to report.

Answer 2nd - Friends maintain love towards each other, becoming our Christian

profession. Slandering and detraction discouraged, and no differences apparent amongst us.

Answer 10th Care is mostly taken to deal with offenders seasonably and impartially, and in the spirit of meekness and love.
