Balt. Monthly Meeting.

1. Lot cor. Eutaw & Monument sts
137 x 72 ft. bought in 3rd Mo. 1864, at
a cost of \$15,000. improved by a meeting
house 54 x 71 ft. built in 1867, at a cost
of \$31,000. (of which \$6276.⁶⁹ was paid
out of money raised from Hicksville stables, & was derived from sale of mtg. hse. cor. Eutaw & Monument sts
by the Jry Mtg.) also, by a school house
29 x 71, built in 1875 by Thos. Wilson &
presented to the Mo. Mtg. & now rented
at \$600. pr. ann. for a girls' school of high
grade.

2. Lot 318 Light st. 56 x 331, bought in
2nd Mo. 1871, at a cost of \$6500. improved
by a Mission building 42 x 120 built in
1880 at a cost of \$14,600. including the
furnishing, fencing & paving.

3. 40 shares Nat. Mechanics Bank stock
worth about \$480. the remnant of a
legacy from Nick. Popplein, Sen.

4. \$2000. of Balt. 6% Loan, payable 1890
& \$532.²⁵ in Central Savings Bank.
This is the proceeds of an old legacy of
\$500. from Andrew Scholfild of Alexandria
for educating poor children of Balt. Mo.
Mtg. There being none such for many
