

by example and precept, to bring up their Children, and those under their care in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, and in that plainness and simplicity of life, which the Gospel enjoin.

They endeavor to guard them from reading pernicious books, and from the corrupt Conversation of the world, and they are encouraged, frequently to read the Holy Scriptures.

Answer 4th Our testimony to a free Gospel Ministry has been maintained agreeably to our discipline.

Answer 5th With a few exceptions, Friends have maintained our testimony against the use of all intoxicating Liquors, and they have avoided drinking houses, and frivolous and demoralizing places of diversion.

Answer 6th The necessities of the poor have been inspected, and when needed relief and advice have been afforded.

Answer 7th Friends Children have been placed in schools, and when practicable

in schools under the care of Friends.

Answer 8th Friends generally maintain a faithful testimony against Oaths, military Services, clandestine trade, prize goods, lotteries & Slavery.

Answer 9th Friends have been careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances - to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage or engaging in hazardous or speculative trades - We believe they have been just in their dealings, and punctual in complying with their engagements with one or two exceptions, under care.

Answer 10th Care has been generally taken to deal with offenders seasonably, and when done, it has been impartial and in the spirit of meekness and love.

Answer 11th Rachel P Brown, an Elder deceased 10th mo 27th 1883, in the 82nd year of her age.

Answer 12th None.
