With the view of increasing the income from the investments of the monthly meeting, which now consist of \$2,000 Balto City Stock redeemable in 1890; 40 shares of National Mechanics Bank of Balto, par value of \$500. and a deposit of \$500 in the Central Savings Bank yielding together an annual income of \$162.30, the Trustees are authorized to sell the above securities, which with the premium on them of \$240 & the Savings Bank deposit will make up the sum of \$3300, and with this amount build four dwellings on the vacant lot on James' Alley 55 ft front, in the

rear of the Gospel Mission property owned by the monthly meeting - They are also authorized to build a janitor's house, on the remaining vacant ground immediately in the rear of the Mission House, if the money can be raised by voluntary subscription - which was referred to the Trustees & they were instructed to proceed at once to carry out the foregoing proposition, unless they see cause to delay.
