Janney, Wm Janney, & Jonas Janney, Junr of record F. F. F. F. folio 327, containing half an acre, more or less; and to pay the net proceeds to the Trustees who now hold the title of the

new meeting house property at Lincoln in said County; said proceeds to be used towards paying the balance due on the new meeting house aforesaid.

Our Clerks were directed to send a copy of the foregoing Minute to Isaac C. Hoge, in order that the proper steps may be taken for the sale of the property.
