

under the control of this meeting. But it having been the apparent intention of the testator to provide in some way for the education of the children of Friends belonging to this meeting, who are or may be in indigent circumstances, they are of opinion that the income should be thus applied, if at any time there should be such objects answering to the description, and meanwhile should be applied to such purposes as will most nearly satisfy such intention.

Your Committee therefore recommend, that the whole of said legacy or fund, consisting of the said City Stock and money now deposited in the Central Savings Bank be committed to the charge of the Trustees of this meeting, with instructions to set the same apart in the name of the "Andrew Scholfield's Bequest" and authority to reinvest the same according to their best judgment and discretion - That the income thereof, hereafter accruing, be applied by the said Trustees towards the education of the children of Friends belonging to this

meeting, if any there be who may need such aid, and if none, then to the use of such schools under the charge of the before mentioned Home Mission Association, as now organized under the name of Friends Association for Christian work, as may in their judgment seem appropriate and proper.
