To Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends
More than a year has elapsed since the last report to the Monthly Meeting respecting the Mission Meeting on Federal Hill - During this time we believe there has been a decided progress in the life and power of that meeting - Individual members have deepened in religious experience and developed gifts in various lines of service that are valuable to the meeting and they work together with more

love and harmony than ever before. A few valued members have moved away and two or three have fallen back into their old habits but their places have been more than filled by new accessions - One of the most encouraging features is the Young Peoples Prayer Meeting begun over two months ago and held entirely by themselves on 1st and 3rd days with an average attendance of 25 to 30 -

During the visit of Caroline E. Palbott in 1st & 2nd months 1887 a series of meetings was held for three weeks at Federal Hill, and again during her visit here the past winter there was another series of meetings lasting four weeks - These efforts were greatly blessed - Many were converted and many Christians were revived - The young people especially were reached and a large proportion of the attenders of nearly all the meetings are still of this class - Rich being the case, it has not been practicable to make the exercises of the meetings conform to the very quiet and serious mode preferred by our own and other long established
