

At an adjourned meeting of Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends for the Eastern and Western Districts held 7th mo 13th 1888 three overseers present.

Our Friend Francis J. King referred to the great loss which this Meeting has sustained in the death of our late, beloved Friend Mary Whitall Thomas and proposed the appointment of a Committee to prepare a suitable memorial of her - Full unity having been expressed with this Francis J. King and Richard H. Thomas, in conjunction with a similar Committee of Women Friends were appointed to prepare such a memorial to be presented to a future meeting.

The Trustees reported that the deed of the Courtland street property had been executed as directed. James C. Thomas on behalf of the Committee appointed to visit J. Russell Charlesworth with reference to his application to be received into membership ^{the Religious Society of} Friends reported that they had had a satisfactory interview with him and were united in recommending that he be received into membership.

This meeting fully united with the judgment of the Committee and women Friends concurring this name was directed to be entered upon our list of members - The Committee was continued to inform

him thereof.

The Committee appointed at our last meeting to bring forward the name of a suitable person to act as Recorder to this meeting proposed the name of Benjamin P. Moore which was united with and he was accordingly appointed to that position. Thomas R. Matthews Jr on behalf of the representatives to our last Quarterly Meeting reported that they all attended.
