4th Ans. - Friends maintain our testimony to a free Gospel Ministry -

5th Ans. - With a few exceptions in each respect Friends maintain our testimony against the use of intoxicating liquors and attending frivolous and demoralizing places of amusement -

6th Ans. - The necessities of those who appear likely to require aid are inspected and advice and relief extended when thought necessary.

7th Ans. - Friends children attend school and when practicable schools under the care of Friends

8th Ans. - Friends avoid oaths, Military Services, clandestine trade, prize food, lotteries and Raffle -

9th Ans. - Friends appear careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances, and to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage or engaging in hazardous or speculative trade - We believe they are just in their dealings and punctual in complying with their engagements

10th Ans. - When necessary, care is taken to deal with offenders seasonably and impartially and in the spirit of meekness and love -
