The Trustees report that they have elected James Cary Thomas as President of the Board in place of Francis T. King deceased. They refer to the report of the Treasurer, to the Monthly Meeting in 1st month last for a financial statement for 1891. of the various funds under their care.

The school building erected by Thomas Wilson has been rented to the John Hopkins University for another year at the same rate, \$1,000. and the rent is being regularly collected and deposited in the Central Savings Bank. Except such sums as are drawn by the Education Committee of the Monthly Meeting - \$2,150 of the surplus has been invested in 1st Mchgo bonds of the Consolidated Gas Co. bearing 6%.

Night school The income from the Schafeld Fund is being used to support a night school at Federal Hill Mission which has been doing a good work the past few months.

The income of the M. & W. Warder Fund goes to the General Mission work at Federal Hill in accordance with the terms of the bequest.

As it was found impossible to recover anything from the Estate of Anna Eliza Hopkins through a lawsuit, the Trustees have decided to let the matter drop.

The following is a list of the property owned by the Monthly Meeting in addition to the two \$1,000 - Consol Gas Co Bonds. a bond referred to as part of the Wilson Fund.

Lot Corner Calver & Monumental Sts. 137 by 72 ft bought 3 Mo 1864 at a cost of \$15,000, improved by a brick meeting house 71 by 54 ft. built in 1867 at a cost of \$31,000, of which \$6,276⁹ was paid out of the funds of the Yearly Meeting; also by a brick school house 72 by 29 ft. built in 1895 by Thomas Wilson and presented to the Monthly Meeting. The total cost of the improvements made by Thomas Wilson was \$19,000.
