

2nd Lot on Light St near Hamburg St 56 ft by 331 ft
bought in 2nd Mo 1841 at a cost of \$6,500 (of
which \$3,000- was contributed by Mules while)
improved by a brick Mission House 42 by 120 ft
built in 1880 at a cost of \$14,600, including
fencing paving and furnishing; also by a Jani-
tors house in the rear of the lot and four
small houses on the rear fronting on Janes
Alley, which are rented out to private families
the income is applied to the purposes of the funds
from which the money to build them was derived.
