

Spoke of a quiet assurance of growth in the Christian life - 2198 yards of cloth were distributed -

The Free Kindergarten opened 9 mo 15 1891 with 53 children and applications for over 100 but the funds would only allow of 63 being permanently kept - They receive one meal and many of them a large portion of their clothing, part of which was made by the "Wholesale Circle" of Kings Daughters - The "Neighbourly Love" Circle and the results of two lectures counterbalanced the loss in individual subscriptions and enabled them to meet the increased expenses and finish the year work with a balance - much good has been accomplished as evidenced by the frequent visits of strangers who had heard of the work -

The Temperance Committee have sent out over 15000 pages of tracts, and addresses have been given in six Sabbath Schools. The Christian Temperance League, an outgrowth from the boys Meeting has in-

creased its membership and the work which it has done causes them to look forward with increased hope for the coming year.

Because of severe illness in the family of the Chairman but no Cottage Meeting has been held -

The Young Womens Christian Fellowship Union have done a work of a general character - Five meetings were held and the promotion of fellowship and building up of Christian life of the young women has been evidenced thereby - The Children's Union under its care held eight meetings and instruction in Peace, Polity and Temperance given - Magic Lantern Exhibitions were included and they believe much good was done. The Hospitality Committee have given their attention to the work and desire the assistance of all their own members, especially in the line of speaking to strangers.
